

Expanding Cardiac Care in Sault Ste. Marie

Minister of Health and Long-Term Care, Dr. Eric Hoskins, announced the Government of Ontario's support for bringing cardiac angioplasty to Sault Ste. Marie. The investment in expanding cardiac care at SAH will mean that each year up to 500 Northerners will no longer have to travel to have angioplasties performed. Improving access and decreasing wait times for cardiac patients will help improve health outcomes and will reduce the burden on families and caregivers in the North East LHIN.
